Signs and symptoms you might notice in yourself or a friend that are good reasons to reach out for help.

Feelings of hopelessness , depressed mood. Withdrawal from friends, family, and activities you used to enjoy

Changes in eating or sleeping patterns.

Feelings of hopelessness , depressed mood.

Feeling tired or exhausted all of the time

Trouble concentratin g, thinking, and focusing

Restless, irritable, or agitated.

Neglect of personal care.

Thoughts about death or suicide.

Get H.O.T. Talk it out!

How to engage in honest, open, and transparent (H.O.T) conversations:

- 1. Identify how you're feeling
- 2. Write down the name of someone you trust
- 3. Write down a date when you'll have a H.O.T conversation
